Revision to Visa-On-Arrival Fee for Travel to Bintan Thursday, 3 July 2014

The Indonesian Government has announced that from 3 July 2014 the Visa-on-Arrival (VOA) fee shall be revised. From this date onwards, all travelers visiting Bintan, Batam or Karimun from the list of countries which are eligible for VOA facility will be charged as follows:

- US\$15 per person for VOA applicable for a stay not exceeding 7-continuous days;
- US\$35 per person for VOA applicable for a stay not exceeding 30-continuous days.

The following conditions will continue to apply:

- The above VOA fees are applicable only to visitors travelling for leisure activities, conferences, exhibitions and national/regional/international/governmental seminars;
- For visitors to Bintan, the fee is paid upon arrival at the Immigration Checkpoint at Bandar Bentan Telani (BBT) Ferry Terminal or the Ferry Terminal at Bintan Lagoon Resort;
- There is strictly no extension of the 7-day or 30-day VOA and it supersedes all other Indonesian visas that a person may be holding.

For passengers travelling in Emerald Class on Bintan Resort Ferries, the VOA can be conveniently purchased on-board, en-route to Bintan.

Visitors are advised to bring along with them the exact amount in US\$ for the payment of VOA fees and to have on hand the following documents:

- Passport with a minimum validity of 6 months from the date of travel
- Fully completed Arrival/Departure Card
- Return journey ticket
